

Call for scientists!

The Sherman Park WaterMarks Project Team, which is led by your fellow Sherman Park residents, is seeking scientists to lead community walks.

WaterMarks Walks pair local artists with scientists and science perspectives to coordinate neighborhood walks. Each walk will encourage residents and stakeholders to think about the unique environmental challenges within our community, and how these issues can be addressed and overcome.

We are seeking individuals with a grounding in scientific or technical knowledge of freshwater to lead a pair of community walks alongside an artist, discussing water issues in Sherman Park from scientific, artistic, and community perspectives.

Individuals do not need to have a specific scientific degree; rather they need to be a person that is working in a STEM career, working in a STEM education career, or pursuing an advanced STEM degree. Individuals must be willing to speak about water-related issues. For each walk, the individual will receive a \$350 stipend for walk preparation and execution.

Ideally, the individual lives in the Sherman Park community or has ties to the neighborhood.
